A free beginner cross stitch pattern



A tiny cozy make for an evening cup of tea

- 25 x 25 stitches
- 6 simple colors
- Full symbol chart and color key
- Designed from scratch for this pilot

Sleepy Tea Cat - symbol chart

Each square represents one full cross stitch. Heavy lines mark 5-stitch blocks.

Tip: start near the center of the chart and work outward.

Color key and beginner notes

	Deep plum outline	Choose the closest floss shade you already own
	Warm cream cat	Choose the closest floss shade you already own
	Terracotta teacup	Choose the closest floss shade you already own
	Blush detail	Choose the closest floss shade you already own
	Sage accent	Choose the closest floss shade you already own
	Charcoal face	Choose the closest floss shade you already own

Quick start

1. Use 14-count Aida and two strands of cotton embroidery floss.
2. The stitched motif is about 4.5 x 4.5 cm on 14-count Aida.
3. Work every top leg of each cross in the same direction for a neat finish.
4. The palette is intentionally flexible; exact commercial thread numbers are not required.
5. Finish in a 10 cm hoop, a card, a patch, or a tiny framed gift.
